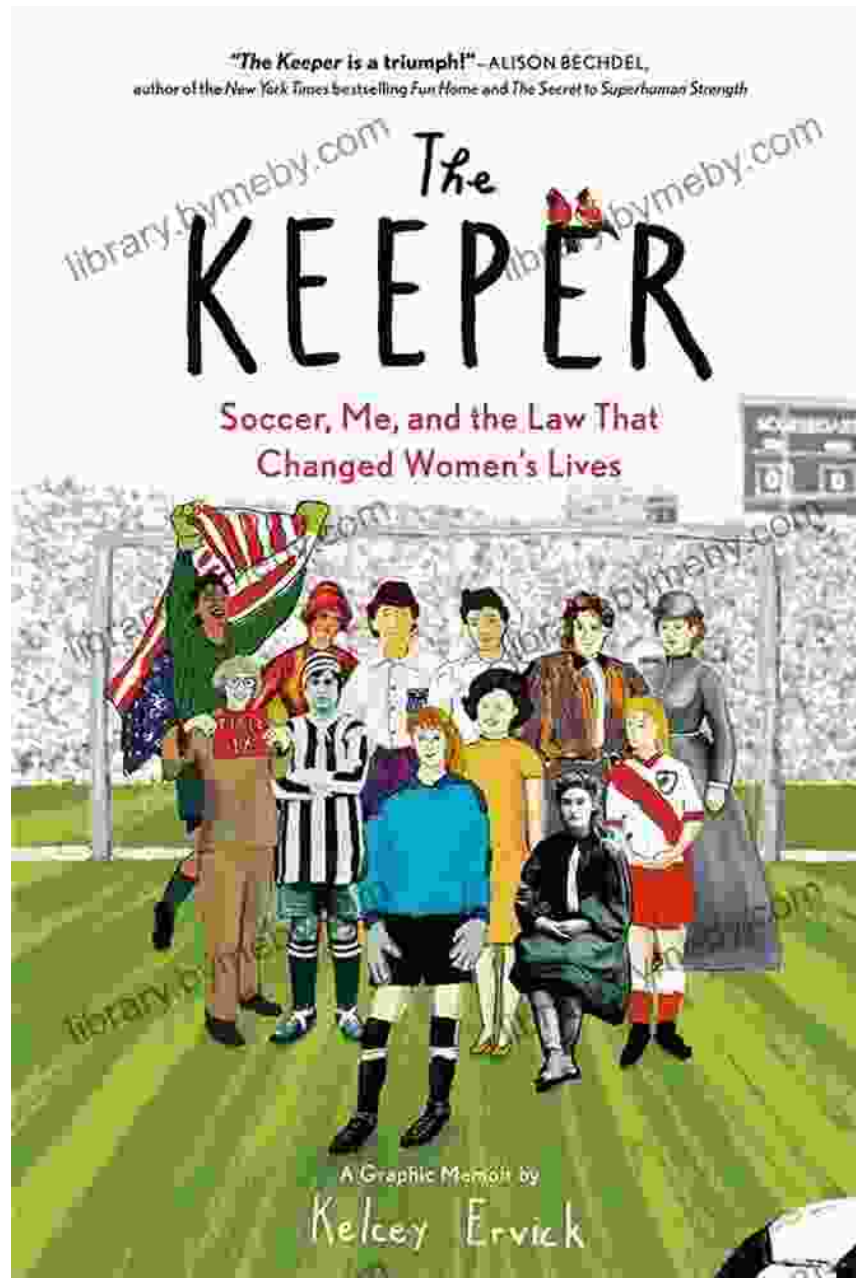


# Soccer, Me, and the Law That Changed Women's Lives

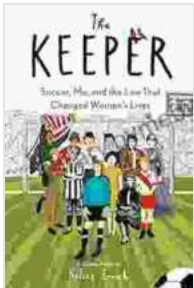

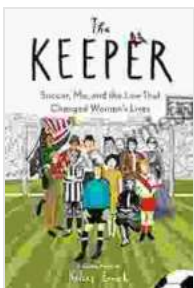
