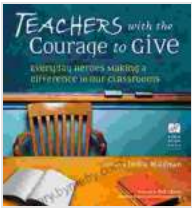

There are many ways that you can help teachers make a difference in the lives of their students. One way is to donate to organizations that support

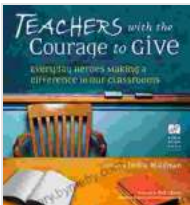
teachers and education. You can also volunteer your time to help teachers in your community. And most importantly, you can show your appreciation for teachers by letting them know how much you value their work.

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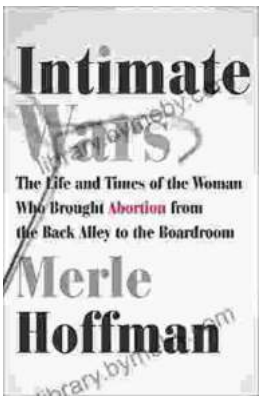
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
